

Holy Night

This beautiful Christmas card is really quick and simple to make, very handy if you need to make quite a few.

Materials Required:

3mm Quilling Paper: Blue, Pink and White.

Quilling Tool.

Scrap of White Card.

Stickers: XL563U and XL564U.

Silver and Clear Micro Glitter.

Clear Drying Glue and Fine Tip Applicator.

Gold Pen and Ruler.

Tracing Paper and Craft Knife.

Sticky Fixers.

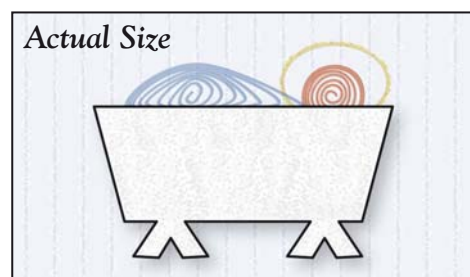
P.V.A. Craft Adhesive.

Card Mount:

DEC9U-69 Cryogen White.

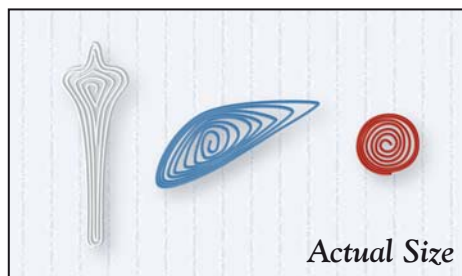
To Make The Card:

Draw the star using the gold pen and the ruler, ensuring the long line is exactly in the centre of the card. The centre line should start 5mm from the top of the card and be 9.5cm long. The centre horizontal line should be drawn at 3.5cm from the top of the card and start and end 5mm from the edge of the card. The two diagonal lines are 64mm long and centred over the cross already drawn.



Trace the crib from the diagram below left, retrace onto white card and cut out. Cover this with the clear glue, sprinkle over with clear glitter and set aside to dry.

Use a 30cm length of blue paper wound to a loose coil. Pinch one end to form a teardrop then press the bulb of the teardrop about 2.5cm from the point between the finger and thumb to make a flat sided shape for the body.



Use an 11cm length of pink paper wound to a loose coil to make the head.

Use a full length of white paper wound to a loose coil, pinch both ends to form an eye shape. Pinch and hold one end of this eye about two thirds of the way along the length and pinch the other end with the other hand while pushing both hands together, this will push out the two sides which you should pinch between your two fingers and two thumbs while still holding all the other bits!

You can let go now and the shape will open out a bit. Apply a little glue to the back of the shape, pinch and hold the long point keeping hold of it until the glue has dried. Stick onto the card aligning the two side points with the centre.

Shake any excess glitter off the crib and place two stacks of two sticky fixers on the back



(not too close to the top). Stick onto the card below the star and glue the body and head into place tucking them under the top of the crib. Draw the halo with gold pen.

Cover the quilled star with clear glue and sprinkle with silver glitter, shake off any excess.

Use the fine nozzle and the clear glue to draw over all the gold pen lines (including the halo). Sprinkle with clear glitter, tap off the excess and leave to dry. Add the Holy Night wording below the crib.
